In 2022, the American Society of Regional Anesthesia and Pain Medicine (ASRA) awarded Dr. Tsui the Distinguished Service Award. This prestigious annual award has been presented to honor persons who have made remarkable contributions to regional anesthesia and pain medicine.

Previously, Dr. Tsui held the positions of director of pediatric regional anesthesia at Stanford University, full professor, and associate chief of the division of regional anesthesia.
